Cardiac Arrhythmia Service

Provides diagnostic and therapeutic options including:

- Invasive electrophysiologic techniques for diagnosis and treatment of cardiac arrhythmias using radiofrequency ablation techniques;
- Pharmacologic therapy with standard and investigational agents;
- Implantation and follow-up of pacemakers and/or defibrillators; and
- Arrhythmia ablation and comprehensive non-invasive arrhythmia and syncope evaluation including continuous and event ambulatory monitoring, signal-averaged ECG, upright tilt-testing, and esophageal pacing and recording.

Availability:

- 24-hour emergency coverage is available for inpatient and emergency room evaluations.
- Cardiac device clinic is held on Mondays.
- Outpatient arrhythmia consults are on Tuesday by appointment.
- Inpatient consults are available at any time.
- 24-hour ambulatory ECG monitoring, event monitoring and signal averaged ECG are scheduled through the diagnostic testing appointment line.
